The Lake Chad Basin Commission (LCBC) received funding from the International Development Association (IDA) to support the Lake Chad Region Recovery and Development Project (PROLAC). Part of this grant will be used to make payments under a service contract for a consultant responsible for mapping research equipment in universities and research institutions across the Lake Chad Basin.

The consultant's role is to assist the Project Implementation Unit by identifying, cataloguing, and evaluating the research equipment available at universities and research institutions in the region. This initiative aims to enhance the accessibility and optimal use of research equipment by researchers and students across the Lake Chad Basin.

The consultant will be required to develop and share with LCBC the methodology for each stage of the research equipment mapping process.

The total duration of the service will be sixty (60) calendar days, covering key universities and research institutions in the Lake Chad Basin, including those in Chad, Cameroon, Niger, and Nigeria.
