1. The Lake Chad Basin Commission (LCBC) received funding from the African Development Bank Group to cover the cost of the **Technical Support Project for the Restoration of the Ecological and Economic Functions of the Lake Chad Basin**. The Lake Chad Basin Commission (LCBC) plans to allocate part of the funds from this grant to finance a contract to conduct technical studies, including PPD and DPD, to improve the hydraulic capacity of the Chari-Logone system and the Komadougou-Yobe basin, and to support the development of Lake Chad. It also includes **economic and financial analysis, a comprehensive study of vulnerability to climate risks, an assessment of the basin's capacity to mitigate climate change, a detailed Environmental and Social Impact Assessment, and the preparation of a resettlement action plan and procurement documents.**
2. The services under this contract include preparing the PPD and DPD to enhance the hydraulic capacity and development of Lake Chad; conducting economic and financial analysis of the chosen development options; assessing climate vulnerability and proposing mitigation measures; conducting Environmental and Social Impact Assessments (ESIA); and preparing procurement documents for project implementation.
3. The duration of the assignment is twenty-four (24) months from the date of notification of commencement of services issued by the Project Coordinator.
4. The Lake Chad Basin Commission (LCBC) invites specialised firms to express their interest in providing the services described above. Interested firms and agencies must submit information demonstrating their capacity and experience to deliver the services, including documentation,

references for similar assignments, experience with comparable missions, and the availability of qualified personnel.
