The Lake Chad Basin Commission (LCBC), in collaboration with GWP-Central Africa (GWP-Caff), received funding from the World Meteorological Organisation (WMO) to cover the costs of the project titled "Integrated Water Resources Management and Early Warning System for Climate Change Resilience in the Lake Chad Basin." The project aims to increase the resilience of communities in the Lake Chad Basin by strengthening countries' capacity to manage and adapt to climate-related risks through improved hydrological monitoring, data systems, service delivery and awareness-raising about climate hazards, via the following four (4) components: (i) Strengthening regional hydrometeorological observation and climate information systems; (ii) Identifying and developing hydrometeorological products and services; (iii) Raising awareness amongst decision-makers, legislators and water users of the importance of hydrometeorological information and services (including timely communication and dissemination of products and services tailored to end-users); (iv) Developing response plans and building capacity for communities to cope with climate risks and hazards.

LCBC, as the project's implementing agency, is responsible for planning, organising, overall technical design, and implementation of the activities under the Lake Chad Basin Fund Adaptation Project.

To implement this project, a Project Implementation Unit is being set up under the supervision of the Technical Department of LCBC.

LCBC intends to recruit an Integrated Water Resources Management Expert (IWRM) to lead the overall technical design and conduct the activities of the Lake Chad Basin Adaptation Fund Project, including the design and development of systems.
